



 Hawkish Monetary Policy: when Central Bank increases the rate of CLR, SLR, Bank, Repo Rate, etc. CCR: % if money bank keeps with themselves in the form of cash, no returns in this ex: Cash

SLR: certain % of net demand and liabilities kept by bank in the form of liquid assets, returns in this

ex: gold and government securities

RBI: Monitory Policy Committee (6 members)
When CLR and SLR more, inflation in economy
