**Conjunction** joins two words or clauses

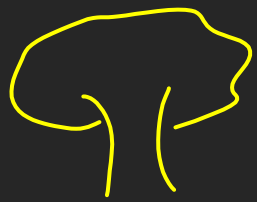
(N) Sub (conj) Sub (N) HV MV

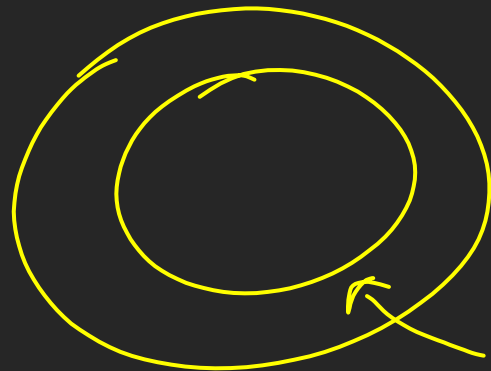

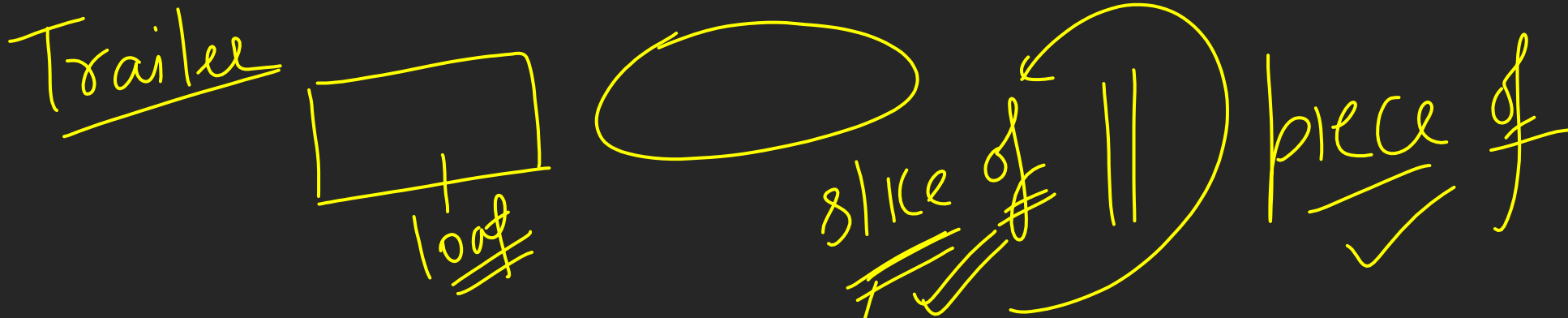
