→ Durga temple at Aihole — 1400 yrs ago

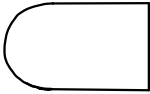

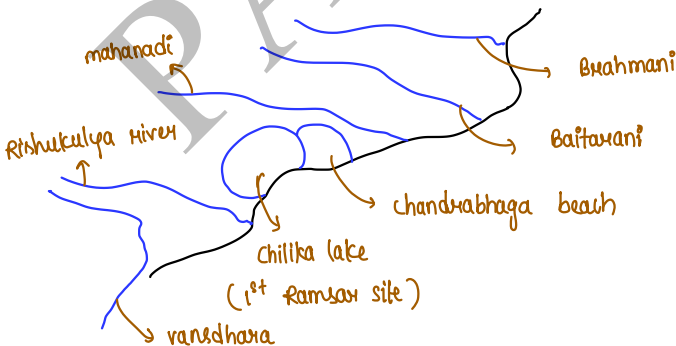

- Art 143 - constitution of India authorises the President to seek the opinion of Supreme Court in specific categories of matters
 ↳ taken from CANADA
 ↳ not binding in nature

- CANADA - Residuary power to be vested with the centre
 - Federation with a strong centre
 - Appointment of Governor by centre in State

→ office of governor - GOI Act 1935

→ Sports, Health, Police — state list

→ Birds like Pheasant & monals - Temperate Deciduous forest

→ India forest state Report (IFSR) : Bi-ennial Report

Forest + Tree cover = 24.62% $\begin{cases} \text{Forest} = 21.72\% \\ \text{Tree} = 2.91\% \end{cases}$

Highest forest cover (Area) - Madhya Pradesh > Arunachal Pradesh > Chhattisgarh

Forest policy 1988 target - 33% forest cover

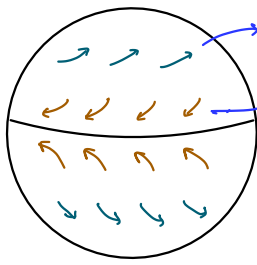

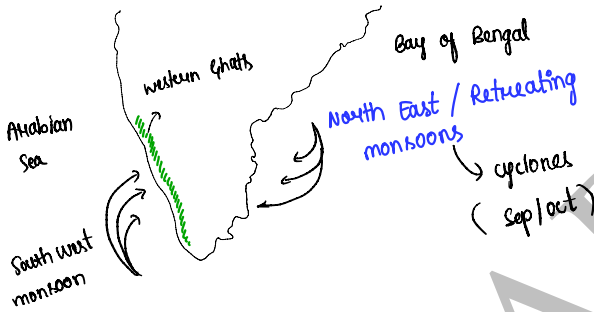


westerlies (from west to east) - trade winds
