Right to Freedom: Art. 19 to art. 22

Art. 19 guarantees to all the citizens the six rights

- (a) Right to freedom of speech and expression.
- (b) Right to assemble peacefully and without arms.
- (c) Right to form associations or unions.
- (d) Right to move freely throughout the territory of India.
- (e) Right to reside and settle in any part of the territory of India.
- (f) Right to practice any profession or to carry on any occupation, trade, and business.

Article 20- Protection in respect of conviction for offences.

Article 21- Protection of life and personal liberty.

Article 22- Protection against arrest and detention in certain cases.

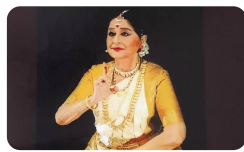

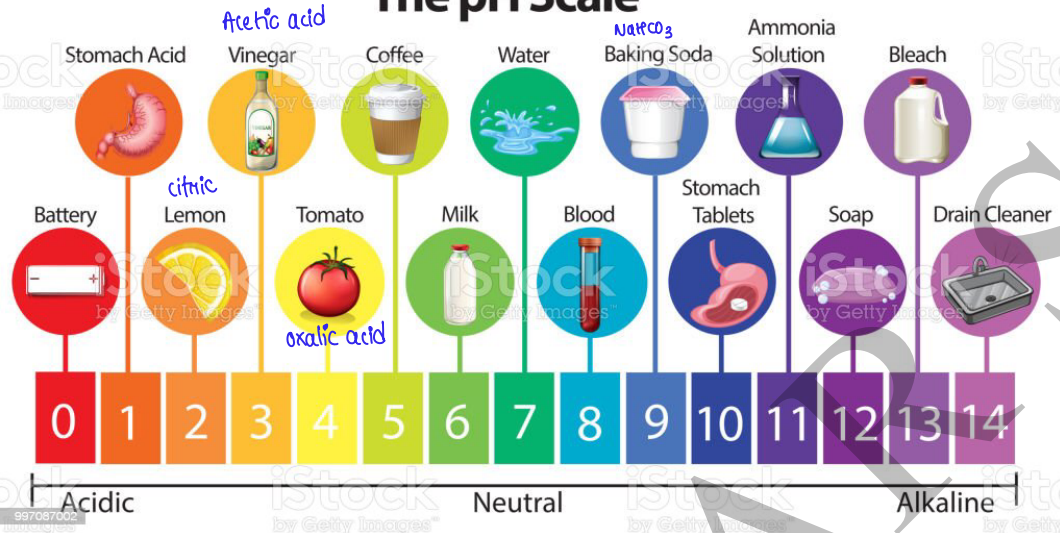

## Article 75 in The Constitution Of India 1949

### 75. Other provisions as to Ministers

- (1) The Prime Minister shall be appointed by the President and the other Ministers shall be appointed by the President on the advice of the Prime Minister
  - (2) The Minister shall hold office during the pleasure of the President
  - (3) The Council of Ministers shall be collectively responsible to the House of the People
  - (4) Before a Minister enters upon his office, the President shall administer to him the oaths of office and of secrecy according to the forms set out for the purpose in the Third Schedule
  - (5) A Minister who for any period of six consecutive months is not a member of either House of Parliament shall at the expiration of that period cease to be a Minister
  - (6) The salaries and allowances of Ministers shall be such as Parliament may from time to time by law determine and, until Parliament so determines, shall be as specified in the Second Schedule
